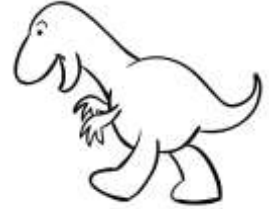

They are very hungry Chomp! Chomp! Chomp!



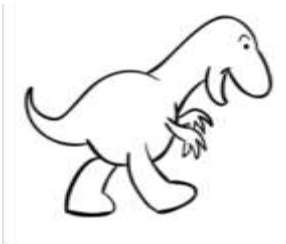
If you're a Tyrannosaurus

The seeds begin to grow...

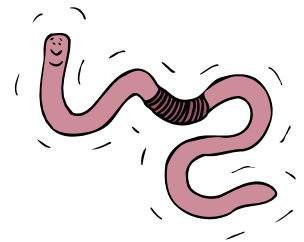


Grow, Grow, Grow
